2021 is coming to an end. While we have a slightly better year compared to 2020, coronavirus is still around us.


In the past two years we've adapted to lockdowns and restrictions and all these have shown how lonely it could feel if we were totally disconnected with the outside world and if everything was done online.

Good news have arrived as Christmas approaches. The West and North Northamptonshire Councils (WNC & NNC) are looking for community projects to support.

Based on the amount of the potential grants, we have identified two potential projects to bid for. I have submitted an application for a £15,000 grant to set up community transport services along the A508 corridor around Brixworth area. The fund support the set-up costs and the operating costs of the service for up to a year.

In North Northamptonshire, we will put in an application for a new community bus route serving the communities of **Loddington, Thorpe Malsor, Great Cransley and Pytchley** and provide them a weekly bus service to Kettering town, which will be similar to the current 78D service. The £5,000 grant would support the operating cost for up to a year.

When considering whether to award the grants, the judging panel will look for evidence of community support. If you or anyone you know would benefit from the above projects, **please do contact us by emailing info@cmbus.org**. We will forward your message to the judges and let them know how public transport services can be the lifeline for communities.
